Midpoint Check-Up

Feb 10 | Read from the Mark Reading Plan every week.

Feb 17 | Set and keep boundaries. Turn off the distractions and turn toward your family.

Feb 24 | Live your faith story to your family. Laugh at yourself. Engage tension. Pray in faith.

March 3 | Honor marriage. Pray 4 times a week with your spouse. Dads, sing in church.

March 6 | Dedicate time to pause and to process and to rest.
