- 3. Under what circumstances would you, like Rahab, lie and break the law in order to serve God?
- 4. What promise did the spies make to Rahab before they left her house and the city?

JAN 16: A NEW BEGINNING

JOSHUA 3-4

- 1. Describe a time when you faced the beginning of something new? What were your emotions? How was your stress level?
- 2. How did God show Israel that God was present among them? What experiences and symbols remind you that God is present with you?
- 3. What miracle did God perform that allowed the priests and the people to safely cross the Jordan River at flood stage?
- 4. As Joshua 4 begins, what was the significance of the 12 men chosen and the 12 stones taken out of the Jordan River?
- 5. What legacy did God tell the people to share with their children and future generations? What faith legacy are you going to share with the generations that come after you?

1. The Israelites were itching to conquer the Promised Land. What priorities did God give Joshua before he led the people into battle?

4. What walls have you built between you and God? How can your Christian community march with you to help you tear down those walls?

5. What happened to Rahab in chapter 6? Why was she saved? See Matthew 1:1-17.

JAN 30: REBELLION AND RENEWAL

JOSHUA 7-8

- 1. How is sin like Covid? Describe a time when you have caught sin from others. When has your sin hurt others?
- 2. Describe a time when you tried to hide your sin from someone else. Why did you do this?
- 3. Describe a time when you tried to deny your sin from yourself? What motivated you to close your eyes to your personal sin?
- 4. Describe a time when tried to hide your sin from God? Is that even possible? What motivated you to try to hide from God?
- 5. Confess your sin to God. What challenges do you face as you ask God to forgive you? How can you receive and believe God's forgiveness and renewal in your life?

FEB 6: DECEPTION AND DIVINE INTERVENTION

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JOSHUA 9-10

1. Who are some spiritual deceivers of our day who try to trick people into following untruth?

- 2. In Matthew 10:16, what was Jesus' warning to His followers as He sent them out into the world? What does this mean for in your life?
- 3. Have you ever felt persecuted for your spiritual beliefs and values? Who did you turn to for support in that situation?
- 4. In Joshua 10:12-15, what did Joshua ask God for? How did God intervene to answer Joshua's prayer?
- 5. Joshua is a foreshadowing of Jesus. How was Joshua like Jesus in the way he cared for his people?

FEB 13: CONQUESTS

1. Why did God command His people to conquer those who occupied the Promised Land?

- 1. In Joshua 22, we encounter a family feud. How does family feuding hurt your family? How does feuding among brothers and sisters in Christ hurt God's family?
- 2. What are some of the battles God has fought for you? How has He showed that He is for you?
- 3. Why did the Israelites have to throw out their foreign gods? What "foreign gods" contaminate our homes and our lives? What would be involved in "throwing them out"?
- 4. Choose today! Who is your God and the God of your family? The true God? Or the gods of the culture around you?
