

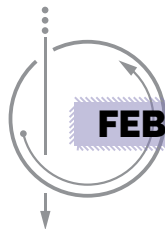

FEBRUARY 5: HUSBAND & WIFE

- **Read Matthew 19:4-6.** The two shall become one flesh in marriage. Marriage includes promises. How can man and woman honor God and show God's love to others through their marriage?

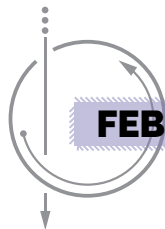

GENESIS 3:1-7

- Discuss some things that your parents tell you not to do. God and parents both have rules they want obeyed! Why do you think that is?
- Describe the serpent. Who does he represent? How did he twist God's command?
- How did Adam and Eve feel after they followed the temptation? How will you feel after following temptations?
- How do you feel after following God? Why is it better to follow God?

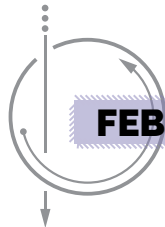

- What's the best way to move forward after doing something wrong?

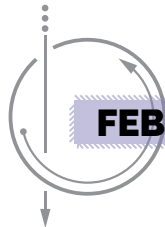

- God provided hope in vs. 15. What loving act does this refer to, and how does this provide a way for us to be with God again? (See 2 Corinthians 5:17-21)

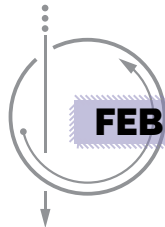
