

APRIL 16 : WORSHIP


ROMANS 12:1-2

- We serve Jesus when we serve others. What are some ways you can love and serve your family? Your neighbors? Your church? Strangers?

APRIL 30 : GROW

2 TIMOTHY 3:14-17

- Ask someone to take notes for you as you tell them a story. Who is the author of that story, the note-taker or you? Read 2 Peter 1:21. Do you believe the Bible is completely God's Word?
- How much time do you spend reading or listening to the Bible? Do you read the Bible like any other book, or do you let the Bible affect your heart? How can changing your heart change your thoughts and actions?
- The Holy Spirit helps you understand the Bible, and the Bible is "profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness." Are you letting God's Word guide you to be more like Jesus? Who do you know that might need to hear about Jesus?

MAY 7: INVITE

ACTS 8:26-39

- Who told Philip to go to the desert? Who told him to go to the chariot? How did Philip respond each time?

- Have you ever felt like you should go talk to someone? How did you respond to that feeling?
- Are you willing to share your knowledge of God with anyone who asks you? Who are you willing to invite someone to a church service, class, or serving event with you?
